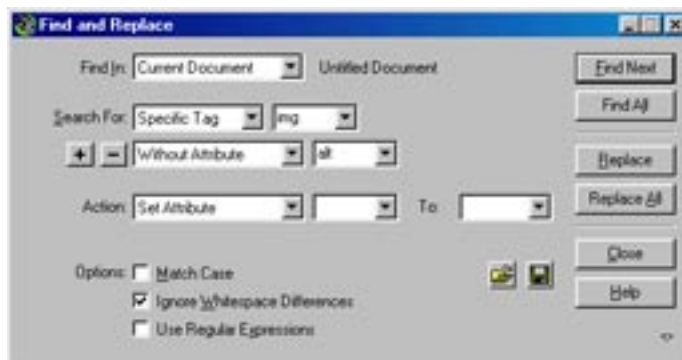


Dreamweaver Find and Replace

Dreamweaver's Find and Replace command can be used to search for specific tags, portions of source code, or text that appears on a page. You can search in the current file, a certain selection of files, or an entire web site. Actions can be created to perform surprisingly specific tasks.

Replace Specific Tag in Current Document

In this example we will search for all image tags in the current document that don't have the alt attribute.



1. Open the Find and Replace dialog box (Edit > Find and Replace).
2. From the Find In pop-up menu, choose Current Document.
3. From the Search For pop-up menu, choose "Specific Tag," and enter `img` in the box next to it. From the pop-up menu directly below, choose "Without Attribute." Type or choose `alt` in the box that appears next to the menu (see left).
4. Click on the Find Next button to locate the next place in the document in which there's an `img` tag with no alt attribute. As each occurrence is located, manually add a proper alt tag.

To Search Entire Site

You must be working with a "defined" Dreamweaver Site in order to use the "Entire Local Site" option with the Find and Replace command.

Replace Source Code in Entire Local Site

In this example we will change all white background colors on the site to green.

1. Open the Find and Replace dialog box (Edit > Find and Replace); from the Find In pop-up menu, choose Entire Local Site.
2. From the Search For menu, choose Source Code, and type `bgcolor="#FFFFFF"` (white) in the text field.
3. In the Replace With box type `bgcolor="#CCFFCC"` (light green).
4. Click on the Replace All button to make the changes.

Replace Selected Text in Selected Files

In this example we will search for text in selected files on the site.

1. In the Site Files Window highlight all files in which you would like to search. Hold down the shift key to select more than one file (contiguous files only).
2. Open the Find and Replace dialog box (Edit > Find and Replace); from the Find In pop-up menu, choose Selected Files in Site.
3. From the Search For menu, choose Text and continue with the search and replace operation as shown above.
